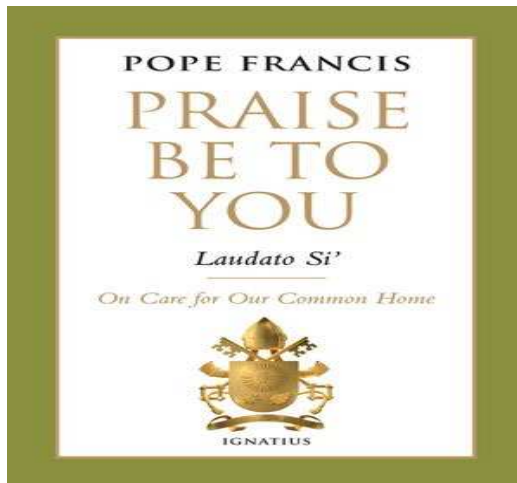

Pope Francis' encyclical, "Laudato Si", focusses on the environment and climate change.

In "Laudato Si - Care of our common home," Pope Francis urges society to move away from the myth of continuing progress at the expense of the Earth's resources, and calls on us to recognise that development which fails to respect the Earth is a false economy.

Far from telling us how we must live, he calls for an open dialogue in society about how best to tackle the global issues we face.

One of these global issues includes climate change and our Holy Father calls for a bottom-up approach that puts care for the very poorest at the centre of the way we live our lives.

The Holy Father emphasises the connection between environmental degradation and poverty, between the love for creation and poverty reduction and the interconnection between human dignity, human development and human ecology.
