I'm sure you will be aware that in the RC Church we have designations of those who may perform certain duties whether they do so as the Ordinary Minister or the extra-Ordinary Minister. The most obvious example is in the distribution of holy communion. In this function the Ordinary Minister is an Ordained Minister but members of the laity exercise that function as extra-Ordinary Ministers when sufficient numbers of Ordained Ministers are not available. In the Sacrament of Confirmation the Bishop is the Ordinary Minister and the priest is the extra-Ordinary Minister and should only be called upon to confer the Sacrament when the Bishop is not able to be present.

Bishop Nolan would like to be present as the Ordinary Minister of the Sacrament at all Confirmations in the diocese of our young people. To that end then he has announced that in February 2017 he will conduct "area" celebrations for the Sacrament separating it from the First Communion day which will continue to take place in the children's home parish. Here in our area the Bishop will confer the Rite of Confirmation on Friday 24th February 2017 at a 7pm service in St Andrew's, Dumfries for all the eligible children in Dumfries, Lockerbie, Moffat and Annan. We embrace this change and look forward to this wonderful celebration. Parents of the parish who have not already done so should register their child for the reception of the Sacraments directly with Fr Jim now.

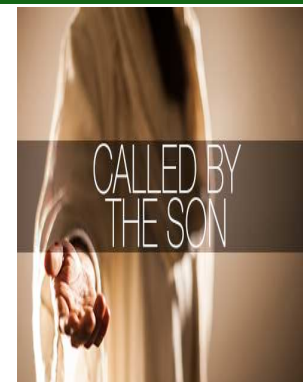
