



PILGRIMAGE TO WHITHORN. ROME PILGRIMAGE 2016. Bishop Nolan has announced a diocesan pilgrimage to the eternal city for the Year of Mercy. The details are: Depart from Glasgow airport on Jet2 flight on Thursday 2nd June till Thursday 9th June 2016 led by Bishop Nolan. Estimated price is £830 which includes 7 nights half-board accommodation based in the 3* Hotel Olympic with visits to all the major Basilicas and a day trip to Assisi. Booking Forms are now available at the back of church and should be returned to Alba Tours with your deposit. There are only 5 places left on the pilgrimage so if you are still thinking about it you should contact the travel agent as soon as you can. Fr Jim will gladly arrange for your airport transport using the parish minibus.
