TEACH 2016-2017

The Ababa Project team will speak to us this week-end about the TEACH programme and will be inviting sponsors to sign up to support the children in TEACH for a new school year. It costs £5 per week (the price of a fancy cup of coffee) or £20 per month or £240 per school year to sponsor a child under the care of the Franciscan Missionaries of Our Lady in Ethiopia to attend school. This sponsorship allows the Sisters to provide school premises, a teacher, a school uniform, school equipment (pencil and jotter) a few toiletries (toothbrush, soap etc) and of course a meal every day for the children. You can sponsor a child on your own or a group of family or friends or work colleagues could chip in each month and sponsor a child together. The school year runs from September 2016 till August 2017. Have a chat with one of the team today. Your sponsorship of the TEACH programme is changing lives for the better.
