AUTUMN FAYRE

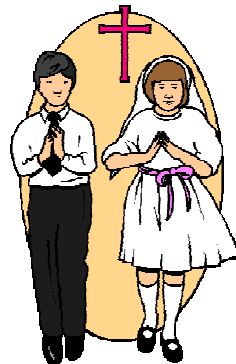
