SAFEGUARDING TRAINING. On the afternoon of Sunday 21st October in the Parish Hall from 2.30pm till approximately 4.15pm all volunteers in our parish and area that work with children and/or adults at risk will take part in the national mandatory Level 1 Induction training session. This training is mandatory for all church volunteers, employees and clergy and assists us all in creating safe and happy environments for all.

THE CATHOLIC CHURCH IN SCOTLAND: SAFEGUARDING STANDARDS.

As you know there is a very well organised Volunteer preparation and selection process across the Catholic Church in Scotland. It is known as "In God's Image". Today our parish Safeguarding Co-ordinators, John and Catherine will make our annual update. We would like to make you aware of the following principle:

POLICY STATEMENT

"All components of the Catholic Church in Scotland, especially those in positions of leadership and responsibility, value the lives, wholeness, safety and well-being of each individual person within God's purpose for everyone. We seek to uphold the highest safeguarding standards in our relationships with people of all ages who are involved in whatever capacity with the Church and its organisations. And therefore, as a Church community, we accept that it is the responsibility of all of us—ordained, professed, employed and voluntary members—to work together to protect children and vulnerable adults from abuse or harm." (Section A-Our Commitment to Safeguarding). This statement and further information is available on the parish website.
