

The Rosary is divided into 5 decades (tens) each representing an event of Jesus' life. There are four sets of mysteries: The Joyful, Luminous, Sorrowful and Glorious. The Our Father is said on each of the large beads, followed by 10 Hail Mary's concluding with a Glory Be.
