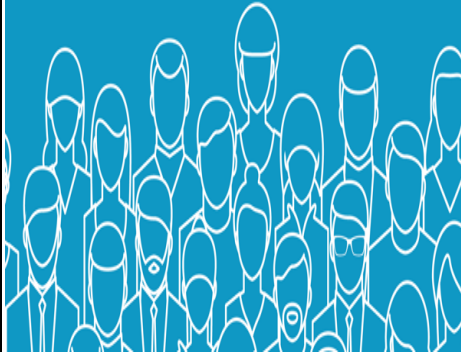

Who do you say I am?

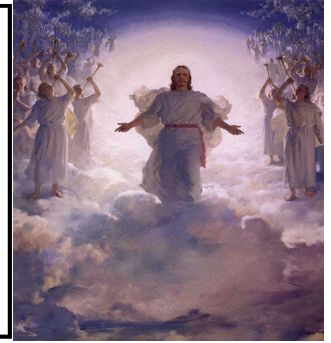
