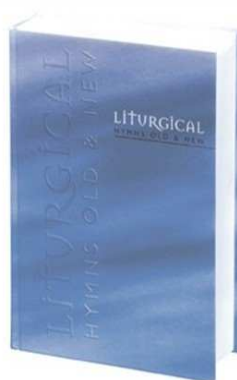


ANNIVERSARY
