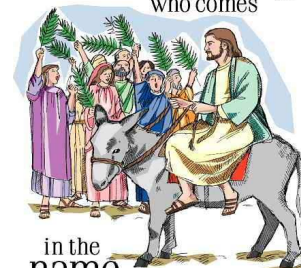

**CHRISM MASS:** The annual Chrism Mass takes place at 7.30pm this coming Tuesday (11th April) in St Margaret's Cathedral, Ayr. The free coach will leave from the church at 5pm. Please sign-up in the church porch.

**GOOD FRIDAY.** This is a day of fasting and abstinence. Church law tells us the ages required to fast are from 18-60 (from 14yrs for abstaining). This is only the second of 2 days left in the liturgical calendar when we are asked to make this sacrifice and those of us who are fit and well of all ages are encouraged to participate. If you are unwell or looking after someone who is unwell you are not obliged in any way.
