END OF PASCHALTIDE.

Today's Mass brings the season of Easter to a magnificent conclusion. We now return to Ordinary Time—the 9th Week of the Year. The Paschal Candle will return to its place by the font and Green is the colour of this season. The next two Sundays however are Solemnities of the Lord: The Most Holy Trinity next Sunday and The Body & Blood of Christ the following (First Holy Communion Day here at St Teresa's). On these occasions the vesture will be White. This year the Solemnity of Saints Peter & Paul falls on Thursday 29th June and is a Holy Day of Obligation for us all. This period is called Ordinary Time in the sense that the Sundays are referred to by their ordinal numbers not because anything insignificant takes place, quite the contrary, over the Ordinary weeks of the year we follow the unfolding of the Paschal Mystery in the life of Christ and his people.
